Student Safety: Bus Loading and Unloading Zone

For the safety of all students, it is critical that the bus loading/unloading zone is clear of parked vehicles and traffic at the beginning and end of each day. Please refrain from driving or parking in the bus zone from 7:40 to 8:30 am and from 2:15 – 3:00. The bus zone includes the wheelchair accessible parking spot. Please do not use visitor parking for dropping off and picking up your children. **Also, please do not let your children onto the playground until 7:55 as that is when our supervision schedule starts.**

We are facing an immediate shortage of substitute bus drivers in the Christopher Lake area. Parents/guardians must be aware that your child's school bus may be cancelled if the regular driver is unable to drive.

We are making every effort to recruit and train new drivers so as to avoid service disruptions, but we need people in your area to fill these roles. You will find that being a bus driver can be a rewarding and satisfying experience. Shift workers and those that are only interested in driving once in a while are urged to give us a call. Being able to work even a couple of days a month can make the difference between a bus running or not.
