Cell Phones

Personal electronic devices such as cell phones, smart watches, tablets and personal gaming devices are not permitted during class time across all K-12 schools in Saskatchewan. This policy is designed to help students stay focused on their learning and engage more deeply with their teachers and classmates. By minimizing distractions, we aim to create a better learning environment where we can achieve Excellence for Every Learner.

At CLPS this means that personal electronic devices will not be allowed in classes, hallways, and during recess. Exemptions may be made at the discretion of the teacher(s), if the use of these devices has a clear educational purpose with limited duration and scope. Personal electronic devices may also be exempt from this policy if there are documented medical or learning needs with which a student requires the use of electronic devices.

Thank you for your understanding and support as we work together to provide the best educational experience for your children. When it comes to ensuring that this important protocol is observed, the following steps will be taken when a student is found using their cell phone when they are not supposed to be:

- ***First Time*** – The staff member will be given the cell phone, and it will be returned to the student at the end of the day.
- ***Second Time*** – The staff member will be given the cell phone, and it will be kept in the Principal's office for the day. A call will be made to the student's parents. The phone will be returned to the student at the end of the day.
- ***Third Time*** – The staff member will be given the cell phone, and it will be kept in the Principal's office for the day. A call will be made to the student's parents for ***them to retrieve the cell phone at their convenience.***

NUT FREE SCHOOL
